Abstract

Author applies four models of professional ethics of politicians (Aristotle's virtuous citizen, Machiavelli's prince, Erasmus' man of values and Weber's responsible politician) to politics and politicians in Slovakia since the first half of the 20th century to the present. According to author, there is possible to identify Milan Hodža with Weber's model, Alexander Dubček with Aristotle's one, Vladimír Mečiar and Róbert Fico are identified with Machiavelli's model and Iveta Radičová with Erasmus' model of professional ethics of politician in Slovakia.
